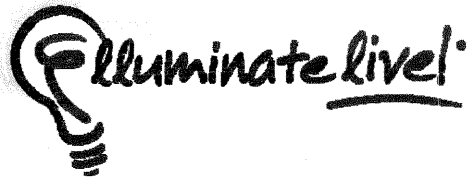

- Supervised Private Chat**: Points to the 'Supervised Private Chat' icon in the chat area.
- Talk Button**: Points to the 'Talk' button in the audio controls.
- Connection, Security, and Recording Status Indicators**: Points to the status bar at the bottom left.
- Microphone & Speaker Controls**: Points to the volume sliders and microphone icon in the audio controls.
- Activity Window**: Points to the 'Activity' window on the right, which shows a log of events and messages.

In-Session

- Be sure to join the session 5 – 10 minutes prior to the start.
- Set your Connection Speed to the Internet.
- Use the Audio Setup Wizard to test your microphone and speakers.

- Use Chat to send text messages to other participants and the moderator during the session.
