The Superintendent's Two Big Levers for Ensuring Success: The Superintendent's New Role on the Governance Team Systemic Accountability

What is SUPES II?

SUPES II is a one-day academy for current superintendents to develop knowledge and skills in two critical areas: governance team success and creating an accountable system.

Why was SUPES II developed?

Our research and our survey interviews with practicing superintendents showed that (beyond state finances) these two issues are at the top of their list of concerns. How can accountability be distributed throughout the school system? How can the superintendent develop and maintain a great board? While both topics are covered to some extent in the original SUPES Academy, a deeper exploration from a practical perspective was expressed as a need.

Who can attend SUPES II?

SUPES II was developed for attendance by **current, practicing superintendents**. Participation in the original SUPES Academy is not a prerequisite.

How will participants benefit?

As a result of participating in SUPES II, superintendents will:

- ✓ understand the superintendent's appropriate role as a member of the governance team
- ✓ gain practical strategies for developing and maintaining a highly effective governance team
- ✓ receive a comprehensive take-home toolkit for use in their own district
- ✓ have a rubric for assessing the status of accountability throughout their systems
- ✓ have strategies for moving from a low accountability to a high accountability system

Participants may earn SB-CEUs for participation in SUPES II.

Who is sponsoring SUPES?

Michigan Leadership Institute (MLI) and the Michigan Institute for Educational Management (MIEM) are collaborating to sponsor SUPES II. All sessions will be taught by Tim Quinn and MLI staff.

When and where will SUPES be held?

SUPES II is a one-day session that will be offered in five locations throughout the state. Each session will begin at 8:30 am and end at 4:00 pm. Specific locations are listed below:
